## *1st Chief Justice Martha Walters Award*

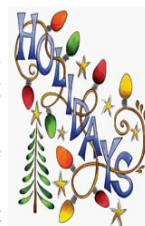

## *Federal Court Filing Changes*

**E-FILING IN FEDERAL COURT?  
PREPARE FOR CM/ECF NEXT GEN NOW!**

On **January 21, 2020**, the U.S. District Court for the District of Oregon will go live on **CM/ECF NextGen**. Attorneys will not be able to login and file with their current CM/ECF usernames and passwords after that date. To e-file with NextGen, attorneys should upgrade their PACER accounts now (if established before 2014 and not yet upgraded). Once NextGen is live, attorneys will link their PACER and NextGen accounts. Once linked, only a single sign on will be required for both systems. 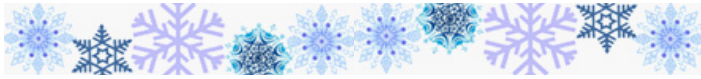
