Online Services for Oregon's circuit courts and the Oregon Tax Court, including OECI, will be unavailable from **October 14, 2021, at 5:00 p.m. to October 19, 2021, at 4:00 a.m.**

The Odyssey case management system for Oregon's circuit courts and the Oregon Tax Court will be offline from **Thursday, October 14, 2021, at 5:00 p.m. to Tuesday, October 19, 2021, at 4:00 a.m.** for an important upgrade. Online services for Oregon's circuit courts and the Oregon Tax Court that rely on Odyssey data, including the Oregon eCourt Case Information system (OECI), will also be unavailable during that time



Court Closures on **Friday, October 15, 2021**

Oregon's circuit courts, the Oregon Tax Court, the Court of Appeals, and the Supreme Court will be closed on **Friday, October 15, 2021**, so that the case management system used by the circuit courts and Tax Court, Odyssey, can be upgraded.
